Every community has its neglected, forgotten and needy people. People everywhere are hurting. Consider making “A Hug in a Bag” for the children to distribute to people they sense are sad and hurting for whatever reason.

Items needed:

- Small party-type goodie bags
- Lifesaver candies, individually wrapped
- Rubber bands
- Toothpicks
- Hugs foil-wrapped candies
- Kisses foil-wrapped candies
- Nails
- Small erasers

Cut apart the messages on the last page of this document and place one in each small, party bag. Make extra copies as needed. Place one of each item listed above in each bag. Instruct the children to give the bags to people who could use a hug. Have them tell the people that Jesus loves them.
