- 1. The soft drink, 7-Up, was invented in St. Louis in 1929 and is still manufactured there.
- 2. A favorite food in St. Louis is pork steak with **barbeque** sauce on it.
- 3. The St. Louis **Gateway** Arch stands 630 feet high and 630 feet wide, making it the tallest monument in the U.S.
- 4. St. Louis was the first American city to host the **Olympics** (1904).
- 5. St. Louis is the home of the world-famous Anheuser Busch Clydesdale horses.
- 6. St. Louis's Major League Baseball team is the **Cardinals**.
- 7. The Cardinals play at Busch Stadium, which sits near the Gateway Arch.
- 8. The 1904 World's Fair in St. Louis popularized many new foods, including the hot dog, ice cream cone and iced tea.
- 9. The first United States kindergarten was started in 1873 by Susan Blow in St. Louis.
- 10. The city was named after King Louis IX of France, who was also known as Saint Louis.
- 11. St. Louis is in **Missouri**, the "**Show Me State**."
- 12. St. Louis is considered the "gateway to the West" and is called Gateway City.
- 13. The **Jewel Box** is an historic greenhouse in Forest Park, which is one of the largest urban parks in the U.S. and a favorite tourist spot.
